O R D E R

Normally, we would not have entertained this petition filed under Article 32 of the Constitution of India and would have granted liberty to the petitioner to approach the jurisdictional High Court. However, having regard to the serious allegations made in the petition and the fact that the issue also relates to the alleged locking of CCTV cameras

during the relevant period at the concerned police station, and further considering that this Bench is monitoring the installation and proper functioning of CCTV cameras at Police Stations, in view of several incidents arising from the State of Rajasthan, we are entertaining this petition.

Issue notice, returnable on 7<sup>th</sup> January, 2026.

In the meantime, the Commissioner of Police, Gautam Buddha Nagar, NOIDA, is directed to ensure that the CCTV footage of the concerned Police Station for the relevant period/concerned duration is neither destroyed nor deleted and is preserved/kept in a sealed cover.
