1. The report of the Institute of Human Behaviour and Allied Sciences (IHBAS) produced before the Court in a sealed cover has been perused after its opening. The same is directed to be kept back in the sealed cover and be returned to Mr. Tushar Sanu, learned counsel for its onwards transmission of IHBAS.
2. During the course of hearing, Ms. X, on a query being raised by the Court, as to whether she is willing to undergo the necessary test by a team of doctors, she has, willingly volunteered.
3. Under these circumstances, before taking any further view in the matter, it would be appropriate, if Ms. X is taken to AIIMS for her mental health examination, by two lady police constables to be deputed by the concerned Assistant Commissioner of Police (ACP) within a period of seven (7) days from today.
