The corpus have been produced in Court.

The officers of Rajasthan Police, Shri Ramswaroop Sharma, Additional SP, Shri Balaram Choudhary, ACP , Ashoknagar, Smt. Santara Meena, CI (SHO Jyoti Nagar) , Shri Sher Singh, SI (Police Line Jaipur) Shri Abdul Raof, HC (Police Line, Jaipur), Shri Siyaram, Police Constable, (Jyoti Nagar), Smt. Priyanka, MFC (Jyoti Nagar), Shri Buduram, Constable, (Metro Jaipur) Shri Manoj, Constable, Shri Vijay Singh, Constable, Shri Vinod, Constable, Shri Dayanand, Constable, Shri Sunil, Constable, Shri Jagdev, Constable (all police line Jaipur) are present.

Mr. Anshuman Singh on instructions appearing for the Police of Rajasthan, submits that corpus were not detained. They were only arrested on 22nd April, 2026 and 1:10, 1:20 and 1:30 PM and were produced before the concerned Magistrate on the same day. They were initially remanded to police custody and thereafter remanded to judicial custody.

Learned counsel submits that corpus had applied for bail before the competent court at Jaipur and bail has been granted however, since the bail

bonds could not be furnished they are still in detention awaiting compliance of bail conditions prior to their release.

Learned counsel submits that corpus were not arrested, neither detained and they were only accompanied by the police officers from Madhya Pradesh to Jaipur. He submits that certain infractions were noticed in the manner in which they were taken to Jaipur and accordingly, appropriate action has been initiated by the competent authority.

Shri B.D. Singh, learned Additional Advocate General has filed a letter dated 28.04.2026 along with certain CCTV footage. He submits that these are the only relevant CCTV footage.

Shri Pramod Kumar Sharma, SI, Shri Tejram Sen (Cyber) P.S. Crime Branch Bhopal are present.

Corpus states that the entire version of Rajasthan police as well as Madhya Pradesh Police is contrary to what transpired.

We direct the Chief Judicial Magistrate to depute an officer to record the statement of the three corpus separately as to what transpired from the time they were allegedly contacted by the Madhya Pradesh police till they were produced before the Magistrate at Jaipur.

Statements be recorded today, thereafter, the corpus be returned back to Jaipur so that they can comply with the bail conditions imposed by the competent court.

Learned counsel appearing for the State of Rajasthan on instructions submits that the entire issue started with an oral communication by DIG, Crime, Commissionerate, Jaipur with DCP Crime, Bhopal.

We direct both these officers to file a detailed affidavit of the entire events between their first communication till the corpus were produced before the Magistrate in their respected jurisdiction.

Let affidavits be filed within one week.

List on 12.05.2026.

Statement be recorded immediately after lunch.

Concerned officers who are present shall be present in court on the next date of hearing also.

Copy of this order be forwarded to CJM concerned.
