O R D E R

1. Learned counsel for the parties have pointed out that the settlement agreement dated 28.11.2025, which has been placed on record jointly through IA No. 129392/2026. It is stated that the parties have amicably resolved their disputes and as per the agreement, the respondent has already paid a sum of Rs.10 lakhs to the petitioner. In furtherance thereto, the parties have applied before the Family Court at Varanasi for dissolution of their marriage through a decree of divorce by mutual consent, and we are informed that the case is now fixed for hearing on 21.07.2026.

2. In light of the subsequent events, the instant Transfer Petition has become infructuous and is disposed of with liberty to the parties to pursue the petition filed under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 before the Family Court at Varanasi. It is made clear that the parties shall abide by the terms and conditions of the agreement.
