16th December, 2025, passed in *LIR No. 2513/2021*, by the Presiding Officer, Labour Court-IX, Rouse Avenue District Court, New Delhi, wherein, the claim of the petitioners have been dismissed on the ground that the Delhi Commission for Women does not classify as an ‘industry’, within the meaning of Section 2(j) of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (“ID Act”).

8. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners draws the attention of this Court to *Annexure P-5*, wherein, the Madhya Pradesh State Women’s Commission has been held to be an ‘industry’.

9. Accordingly, issue notice to the respondents, by all modes.
